From July 26 to 29, 2024, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 1,158 U.S. likely voters in Arizona, Georgia, Nevada, Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin using web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and 2020 recalled vote. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error associated with the sample size is ±3 percentage points. Results for subgroups of the sample are subject to increased margins of error. Partisanship reflected in tabulations is based on self-identified party affiliation, not partisan registration. For more information please visit dataforprogress.org/our-methodology.

- Establishing a Medicare for All Single Payer Healthcare System guaranteeing healthcare to all America
- Eliminating all medical debt Cap the amount of money families spend on childcare at 7% of their income
- Build at least 2 million units of affordable housing Institute a cap on rent increases
- Cut the cost of prescription drugs in half by making sure that Americans pay no more than what they pay in Europe or Canada
- Make public colleges and universities tuition-free
- Make the wealthy and large corporations pay their fair share of taxes
- Cut military spending
